**Re: Proposed Motor Vehicle Rally in Narooma –26 – 28 June 2026**

The Brindabella Motor Sport Club (BMSC) is running a car rally on the 26 – 28 June 2026 in the Dampier and Bodalla State Forests. The 2026 event will be a round of:
